Refreshments will be served following the screening. Admission is free.

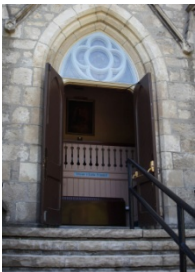


Christmas Crèche Collection
